**WALK IN INTERVIEW for the position of PROJECT ASSOCIATE-I**

A walk-in interview for the position of **PROJECT ASSOCIATE- I** (One Post) under the Central Silk Board, (Ministry of Textiles, Government of India), Bangalore funded collaborative research project on “Evaluation and validation of nutritive and feeding value of silkworm (*Bombyx mori*) pupae meal in broiler and layer chicken” is scheduled to be held on **23.09.2024 (Monday)** at the Department of Animal Nutrition, Veterinary College and Research Institute, Mohanur Road, Namakkal – 637 002. If original certificates are not available, <b>certified copies issued by the custodian of concerned certificates</b> may be produced at the time of interview.
10	Written test	A written test will be conducted for a duration of 30 minutes with maximum of 30 marks. The syllabus includes evaluation of chemical composition and nutritive value of feedstuffs, determination of toxic factors, conducting biological experiments in chicken, data collection and statistical analysis, inventory management, etc. A minimum mark to be secured for attending the interview is 50 %. The pattern will be multiple choice questions. The medium of selection process is English.

**Interested and eligible candidates may bring the filled-in application (with photo) along with enclosures for the walk-in interview. Filled-in applications need not be sent in advance.**

**Selection Procedure:** The selection will be based on marks scored in the written test, educational qualifications – both essential and desirable qualifications, research / work experience, additional skills, recognitions, and performance in the interview. Applicants should submit “No Objection Certificate’ if already employed. Candidates should ensure their eligibility for the position before applying. Documentary evidence to be produced for all claims made in the application form. Any request with respect to change of date / time of interview will not be entertained.

**Other terms and conditions**

1. The individuals have to give prior intimation of 30 days before discontinuing the job.
2. The appointment is made purely on temporary basis and the individuals shouldn't claim any University service later.
3. The individual has to work on all Saturdays. However, they are eligible for leave on Sundays and other holidays declared by the Government of Tamil Nadu / TANUVAS.
4. The decision of the Selection Committee in all matters relating to eligibility, work experience, acceptance or rejection of application will be final and binding on the candidates and no enquiry or correspondence will be entertained from any individual. Original Certificates are to be produced for verification before joining the post.
5. After announcement of the results, the candidate should join the post immediately. No extension of joining time will be allowed. If a candidate fails to join in stipulated time, the next candidate in the merit list will be called for joining the post.
6. The individuals have to make own arrangements with respect to boarding and lodging after joining the post.
7. The selected candidate should work on full time basis.
8. A **medical fitness certificate** has to be produced at the time of joining the said post.
9. A valid **driving license** for driving two-wheeler is must at the time of joining the said post.
